LOUIS M. BROWN SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

PURPOSE

The Louis M. Brown Scholarship Fund seeks to encourage and promote the attainment of higher educational goals for high school men who have excelled in the game of golf, achieved academic excellence in the classroom and have demonstrated leadership in the community.

The state of Illinois has a rich history of men in golf. The Louis M. Brown Scholarship was created in 2009 with a gift from the Meyer Family Foundation. Named after the family's late patriarch, the Louis M. Brown Scholarship strives to perpetuate this goal and provide the means for outstanding student golfers to continue on the path to achieving their academic goals.

SCHOLARSHIP COMPOSITION

- The Illinois PGA Foundation will award a \$2,000 scholarship for the 2009-2010 academic year.
- Applicants will be evaluated based on extracurricular and community involvement, leadership, competitive golf history and academic achievement.
- All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the applicant and her educational institution.
- Scholarship recipient may reapply for \$1,000 awards in sophomore, junior and senior years. Certain requirements apply.

ELIGIBILITY

This educational scholarship is available to graduating high school men who:

- Are residents of Illinois
- Have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement and community involvement
- Have been accepted at an accredited institution of higher learning for the next academic year (verification required)
- Will continue their competitive golf career in college.

HOW TO APPLY

Students must complete and submit the attached application form and supply the following under one cover:

- High School transcript
- Letter(s) from college official verifying acceptance, student-athlete status & eligibility to receive financial aid.
- Letter of recommendation from high school teacher, administrator or golf coach.
- One page essay on what life lessons applicant has learned from golf (not to exceed 500 words).
- All applications must be postmarked by July 1, 2009
